Use Directions:

Apply directly to nymphs and adults and to plant surfaces where they feed and travel. Spray in sufficient water to provide thorough coverage of leaves and stems for best control.

Thoroughly cover the lower trunk and base of trees.

Spotted lanternfly is highly mobile and may reinfest from untreated areas over time.

Repeat treatments should not be made more often than once per 7 days.
